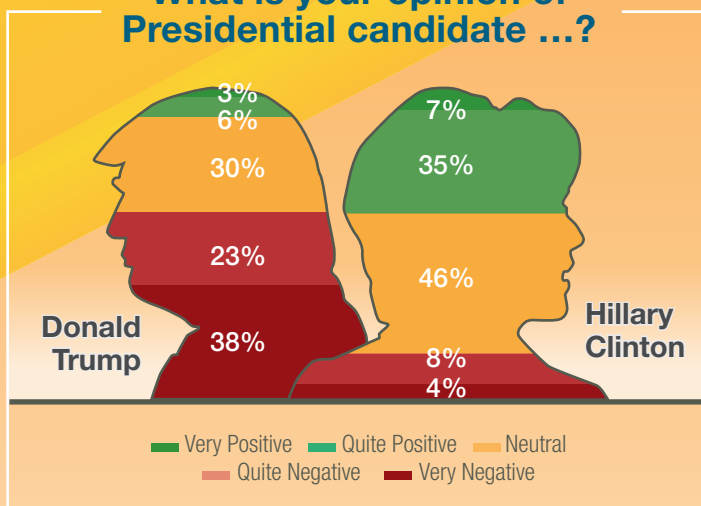


## #US Presidential Race Heating Up

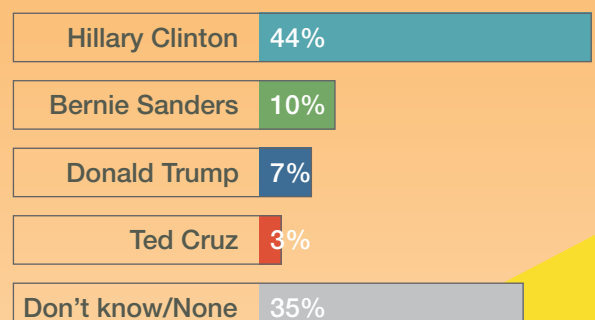
The US Presidential election 2016 is an event observed with great interest internationally. Even Singaporeans cannot resist following the unfolding political race between the likely nominees Hillary Clinton and Donald Trump. Around 6 in 10 Singaporeans say that they have been following news on the presidential election.

Here on the red dot, preferences are already crystal clear – 61% have a negative opinion of Republican frontrunner Donald Trump and only 9% have a positive impression of him. For Democratic candidate Hillary Clinton 42% of Singaporeans have a positive impression.

The Government Satisfaction Index for April remains steady at 72 points overall. Downward corrections observed in the first quarter have settled in and Singaporeans appear to adopt a wait-and-see perspective. Costs are still the main pain for most with satisfaction hovering in the lower 50s. Despite major tightening of the foreigner inflows over the last years, population management remains firmly in the bottom five.
